

Scholarship Application Procedure for 2021

Description of Scholarships: Financial Assistance, Academic, Community Service, Cultural and Sports **Scholarship applications close 11 September 2020**

STEP 1: Complete and Submit Application Form:

The information provided on this Scholarship Application form is confidential and will be used to allow us to consider your scholarship application. This must be accompanied by a completed enrolment form (available from our website) to attend Huanui College. Here we ask for information that will begin the process of enrolment for your child to attend Huanui College and to enable us to maintain contact.

Completed application forms should be posted or delivered to Huanui College, 328 Ngunguru Road, RD3, Whangārei or emailed to info@hc.school.nz by 11 September 2020. Applications must be submitted with supporting documentation, including past school reports and a copy of a passport or birth certificate and all financial documentation as required on the form.

Step 2: Attend Enrolment Interview

This interview is important for everyone including you, your child and Huanui College. It will provide you with the opportunity to meet with our Principal and senior staff in a relaxed setting, discuss Huanui College's culture and expectations and ask any questions you may have. Your child will be required to sit an initial assessment test which provides us with diagnostic information to best inform us regarding the learning of your child. You may be required to return for a second meeting to discuss the details of your scholarship application.

Step 3: The School's Consideration

When assessing scholarship applications and enrolments, each prospective student's educational needs are considered and, where necessary, further information may be requested. Students will need to demonstrate a willingness and ability to support Huanui College's mission to apply themselves academically and participate fully in school life.

Step 4: Offer of Place

If your child's enrolment and/or scholarship application is successful, you will receive a Letter of Offer and an Admissions Agreement. The nature of the scholarship offered will be stated in the Letter of Offer.

Step 5: Acceptance of Offer

To secure a place for your child, you will need to pay the application fee and attend a meeting with the Principal for mutual signing of the Admissions Agreement to confirm your place at Huanui College.

NB: All scholarships are of limited tenure and are reviewed annually. Junior scholarships run from Years 7-9, Middle scholarships Years 10-11, Senior scholarships Years 12-13.
